

D. J. SHARDELOW, JR., ACCIDENTALLY SHOT

Information received here by relatives tells of the accidental shooting near Dyer, Tenn., of Daniel J. Shardlow, Jr., son of D. J. Shardlow, of the Daily News composing room, the accident having occurred while the young man was among the branches of the tree which he had climbed in order to pick some wild grapes. He received about 80 shot in his arm, chest and side, a hunter having shot into the tree when he noticed the leaves moving, which had given the impression that a squirrel was in the tree.

Although he suffered great loss of blood his condition is not considered dangerous and it is expected he will be home with his wather in a week or two. Just last Tuesday a sister, Miss Viva, was buried in Dyer and the mother is ill at this time.

Young Shardlow had been named as an alternate for the contingent of men who will go to Camp Sherman Wednesday, from one of the local districts.
